Also, along these same lines, please remember that our pond and maintenance crews have rights-of-way to enter the HOA property to do their work. We have asked them all not to use your driveways or block your traffic patterns, but sometimes it is infinitely easier for them to access the pond or common area by using an access right-of-way close to your property.
